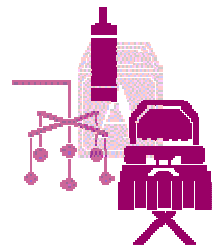
Orville Green has had some bleeding and is growing weaker. He will see the doctor this Friday.
