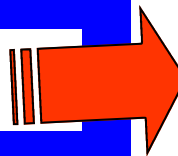

'MYSTERY VISITOR'

Tawnnie, our secretary, gave me an interesting article about a 'Mystery Visitor' going around to local churches in the Wichita area. The Eagle is sending a visitor to a different assembly every other week to critique it. The critiques will be posted in the Faith & Values section of the paper.

The areas the 'Mystery Visitor' critiques are:

Welcome - How well are visitors greeted and made to feel welcomed and accepted?

First Impressions - What are visible impressions of the church

building and the ease of information available to strangers? What is the general attitude given by members about their church? What is the atmosphere of the meeting like? What do the demographics of the church appear to be?

Assembly Format - Is the service traditional, contemporary or a mix of both? Is there weekly communion? Is an overhead screen used? Etc.

Music - What style of music is used? Do guests feel

comfortable joining the singing? Etc.

Sermon - Who Preached? What was the topic? What scriptures were used? Etc.

The 'Mystery Visitor' also gives a synopsis of what he/she believes to be the overall strengths of the congregation's assembly. The first church critiqued received a very favorable review.

I wonder what kind of review we would receive? How do guests see us when they visit? Who knows, we might receive a visit from the 'Mystery Visitor'. Let's continue to work hard to be a genuinely friendly church to everyone!
