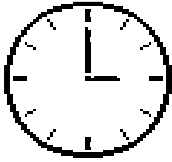

MINISTER'S WIFE CONFESSES TO MURDER - PLANS TO PLEAD "NOT GUILTY"

The fact that a preacher's wife, or any wife, would shoot her husband, leave him in the house, dead, and take off with her three young children is extremely sad. The fact that she was found, confessed to the murder and now plans to plead guilty sounds bizarre. Her attorney said that just because you confess to doing something doesn't automatically mean you are to receive punishment for doing it: confessing is not the same as being punished for guilt.

I'm not sure how the prosecution, the judge, the jury and the court system will deal with the above scenario.

However, the attorney's words hold true in the Biblical sense. In the Scriptures confession to God does not mean you are to be automatically punished for your deed, in fact, confession made to God means you are pleading for mercy, grace and forgiveness. Confession for mercy is possible because of the sacrifice of Jesus. We confess the sin and then plead his blood, which in a way is a plea of not guilty, based on our Lord's guiltlessness. Amazingly enough, confession brings "not guilty".

1 John 1:9 (New International Version)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Confession of sin made to God does not undo any of the horrible deeds we confess. It doesn't make the acts any less harmful to us and others. It doesn't mean we escape all the consequences of the sins. Confession does however, free us from the eternal punishment for our sins.

Romans 8:1 (New Century Version)

So now, those who are in Christ Jesus are not judged guilty.
